time Office Clerks. The Director of Public Works reports to the Mayor.

JOB DUTIES: Must be a visible leader with the ability to delegate authority and responsibility while maintaining

appropriate levels of operational control. Coordinates the annual performance evaluation of subordinates and administers and/or recommends a wide variety of personnel actions including hiring, promotion, termination, and discipline. Issues department work rules and reviews and enforces departmental policies and procedures. Determines departmental priorities for provided

services and recommends capital improvements to the Village's infrastructure.

QUALIFICATIONS: The Village seeks a candidate that possesses strong management, organizational, customer service

and communication skills. The ideal candidate will have experience in strategic planning and organizational development, and possess financial knowledge to include fiscal planning, budget management, and grant writing. Thorough knowledge of municipal public works operations is strongly desired, however exceptional candidates with a proven management track record in other fields may be considered. High school diploma/GED is required. Bachelor's or Master's Degree in

Public Administration, Civil Engineering or related field is preferred, but any equivalent
